

Queen Elizabeth School
One-off Grant for Promotion of a Sports Ambience and MVPA60 in School
Annual Plan in 2026/2027 School Year

According to Education Bureau Circular Memorandum No. 73/2024, the EDB will provide a one-off grant of \$150,000 to support schools in further promoting a sports ambience and MVPA60. The grant can be flexibly deployed before the end of the 2026/2027 school year.

The P.E. Department proposes to allocate \$39,000 from the grant for the 2026/2027 school year to further develop and enhance our policy on creating an active and healthy school campus. This initiative will be tailored to our school context and the developmental needs of our students, aiming to promote a sports ambience and MVPA60. In the previous school years, we utilized \$110,732 from a budget of \$127,000, leaving \$39,268 available for use in the 2026/2027 school years.
