

**Queen Elizabeth School**  
**One-off Grant for Promotion of a Sports Ambience and MVPA60 in School**  
**Annual Report in 2025/2026 School Year**

According to Education Bureau Circular Memorandum No. 73/2024, the EDB will provide a one-off grant of \$150,000 to support schools in further promoting a sports ambience and MVPA60. The Grant can be flexibly deployed before the end of the 2026/2027 school year.

P.E. Department proposed to allocate \$110,000 from the grant in 2025/2026 school year to support the development and enhancement of the policy on active and healthy school campus according to our school context and students' development needs to promote a sports ambience and MVPA60. A total of \$93,812 has been utilized, leaving \$39,268 available for the 2026/2027 school year.
