Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of achievement of the objectives:

By subscribing to an e-book reading platform, we implemented an Extensive Reading Scheme to cater to learner diversity and help students build a broad and solid knowledge base. The platform allowed students to access e-books anytime and anywhere, facilitating flexible learning.

To reinforce values education, the Chinese Language teacher used a book about filial piety introduced during a writer's talk as an extended reading resource, seamlessly integrating it into Chinese writing lessons to support advanced composition instruction.

2. Evaluation of strategies:

Students are required to submit book reports using the e-book platform. Teachers of different subjects design related assignments that reinforce the reading materials, promoting active learning and the application of knowledge across the curriculum. These reading resources enhance students' language proficiency while strengthening values education
