

School History

Our school was founded in 1954 as the first government co-educational Anglo-Chinese secondary school in Hong Kong. The idea of Queen Elizabeth School was first conceived in 1953, the same year that the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II took place. The school came into being in September 1954 and was operated as an afternoon school in the premises of King's College prior to the completion of its present building which was officially opened in October 1955.

School Mission

Our mission is to provide an all-round education to promote the moral, intellectual, physical, social and aesthetic development of students. Through a well-balanced curriculum and a positive learning environment, we offer students opportunities for realizing their potential to the full and growing in a sense of self-discipline, civic responsibility, concern and respect for others as well as commitment to the common good in their service to home, country and humanity.

School Facilities

Located on a knoll overlooking Mongkok, our school campus is pleasant and quiet surrounded by plenty of trees. It comprises a Main Teaching Block, a New Wing and an Annexe. The whole school is air-conditioned with 24 classrooms equipped with interactive white boards, 3 staffrooms, 4 laboratories, and 16 special rooms (e.g. the Computer Assisted Learning Room, the Multi-media Learning Centre, the Lecture Room, the Teaching Resource Room, the Students' Activity Centre and the STEAM Centre). Other facilities



include the School Hall, the School Library, the Parents' Resource Centre, the Guidance Room, the Discipline Room, the Careers and Life Planning Education Room, the Medical Room, a tuck shop, basketball courts, volleyball courts and a grass football field. A lift is installed at the New Wing.



School Camp

Established in 1962, our unique School Camp in Tsam Chuk Wan, Sai Kung is the only school camp in Hong Kong. With the concerted efforts of parents, alumni, teachers and the Camp Warden Association, the School Camp has now developed into a well-facilitated venue catering for a wide range of recreational and learning activities. For decades, the School Camp has provided a valuable training ground for the development of students' generic skills and leadership as well as the promotion of QES fraternity.



Medium of Instruction

English is the medium of instruction adopted in all subjects except Chinese Language, Chinese Literature, Chinese History, Putonghua, Citizenship and Social Development. Students are trained to become biliterate and trilingual.

English-rich Environment within the School

Staff

There are 79 members of staff in our school: the Principal, 3 Assistant Principals, 48 teachers (including I native-speaking English teacher), and 27 non-teaching staff members. 94% of teachers hold the required teaching qualifications. 100% of them are degree-holders and 48% of them have obtained Master's or PhD degrees. All teachers are subject-trained.

Class Structure

There are 24 classes, with a student population of around 760. There are 4 classes in each form from S.I to S.6.




Academic Performance

34 Level 5** were attained. The percentage of students achieving Level 4 or above in all subjects was 76.85%, while the rate for Core subjects was 76.15%. Moreover, 92.2% of the students scored levels 332A2 in core subjects and one elective, which are the entrance requirements for degree programmes of local universities. For the following subjects, over 75% of the students scored Level 4 or above: English Language, Mathematics (Core), Mathematics (Extended Module 2), Physics, Chemistry, Chinese History, Geography, Economics and Information and Communication Technology.

Over 87% in the whole form were awarded degree offers through JUPAS and SNDAS. 55% of the students with JUPAS offer were admitted to the three main universities, namely, The University of Hong Kong, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.

Pastoral Care and School Ethos

Our school is committed to promoting a liberal, harmonious, and supportive school atmosphere conducive to students' all-round and whole-person development. The Health and Sex, Environmental, Moral, Civic and National Education of students is a vital component of the school's holistic approach to education. It is integrated into the curriculum through activities like exhibitions, competitions, talks and sharing organized during Life Education Periods. Together with Counselling and Guidance, Careers and Life Planning Education, Discipline Committee and SEN Coordinator, our education aims to promote the moral, social, emotional and physical development of students, to instill responsible attitudes, values and life skills into students in order to prepare them for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of adulthood. To help our new students adapt to the new school environment, each new student is directly under the care of a senior student under the Big Brothers and Sisters' Scheme.



Inter-level Class Teacher and Inter-class Teacher meetings are regularly held. To help students with their individual needs, our Student Support Team launches School-based After-school Learning and Support Programmes to assist them in their school work. Students can also seek financial assistance as our school has applied for the Student Activities Support Grant. Gifted students are nominated to take part in external competitions and programmes aimed at specific subject areas.

To further enhance students' sense of belonging and promote reading culture in our school, Multi-intelligence Periods have been implemented. During these periods, students are engaged with different interactive activities such as Class Teacher Periods, Life Planning Programme, QES Channel, Chinese Reading, English Reading and Weekly Book Sharing

and "Chill Day" to build a harmonious school environment. By allowing more interactions between teachers and students, their relationships are strengthened. The Life Planning Programme has also been implemented in classes to assist students to understand their interests, abilities, needs and priorities so as to foster students' goal-setting and articulation to progression pathways.

Our school is student-oriented and provides an all-round education. Plenty of opportunities are offered to allow students to learn outside the confines of the classroom to broaden their horizons. Therefore, we put a great deal of emphasis on involvement in extracurricular activities. Such involvement helps students feel being a part of the school community and allows them to develop skills other than purely academic ones. Apart from the 14 academic clubs or societies, students can join different interest groups in various areas:

- **1. Music:** Students can join the School Orchestra, Chinese Orchestra, Wind and Brass Band and School Choir.
- **2. Sports:** Students can play a range of ball games and join different school teams.
- 3. Service and Uniform Groups: Students can join the Camp Warden Association, Community Service Group, Community Youth Club, Junior Police Call, Zonta Club, Scouts, Girl Guides and Red Cross Youth.
- 4. Others: Students can join a variety of interest groups like the Astronomy Club, Bridge & Chess and Board Games Club, Gardening Club, Drama Club (Chinese and English) and Debating Club (Chinese and English).

Every year, we organize various school activities such as Christmas Concert, Annual Christmas Ball, Joint-school Oral Practice and Joint-school Concert.

學校簡史

本校創辦於一九五四年,是全港首間政府男女英文中學。建校計劃於一九五三年構思,該年正值英國女皇伊利沙伯二世登基,本校亦因此得名。一九五四年九月,本校借用英皇書院校舍開辦下午校,至一九五五年十月正式遷至現址。

辦學宗旨

本校辦學宗旨在為學生提供全人教育,使學生在德、智、體、群、美五方面得到理想的發展。本校亦透過均衡的課程及富啟發性的學習環境,讓學生充份發展各方面的潛能,並培養他們的自律能力、公民責任、關懷及尊敬他人的美德,貫徹校訓「修己善群」的精神,進德修業,服務社群。

校訓

修己善群

校舍設備

本校位於九龍旺角洗衣街和太子道西交界的小山丘上,環境優美寧靜,綠樹成蔭。校園由主教學樓、新翼及副教學樓組成。全校安裝冷氣,共有二十四間課室(設有互動觸控電子白板),三間教員室、四間實驗室、十六間特別室(電腦輔助教學室、多用途學習中心、演講室、教師資源中心、學生活動中心和STEAM教育中心等)。其他設施還包括禮堂、圖書館、家長資源中心、輔導室、訓導室、職業及生涯規劃輔導室、醫療室、小食部、籃球場、排球場、草地足球場等。而校舍新翼設有升降機,方便傷健人士使用。

校營

校營位於西貢斬竹灣,於一九六二年創立,屬全港獨有。經過家長、校友、老師和營地管理員多年來的努力,校營現時設備完善,適合籌辦多元化學習和康樂活動,既能培養學生的共通能力與訓練領導才能,也能發揚伊中友愛協作的精神。

教學語言

本校以英語為教學語言。除中國語文、中國文學、中國歷史、普通話及公民與社會發展科外,其他科目均以英語授課。同時本校亦致力提高學生兩文三語的水平。



英語校園

為推動同學在課堂內外運用英語,本校除舉辦多 項生活化的英語課程及活動外,亦鼓勵同學參與 校內及校外不同類型的比賽。(詳情請參閱英文版)

教職員編制

本校全體教職員共七十九位,包括校長、三位副 校長、四十八位教員(其中一位為外籍英語教師) 及二十七位非教學人員。本校師資優良,94%老 師均已接受認可師資培訓,100%具大學學位,其 中48%更取得碩士或博士學位。所有學科任教老 師均曾接受本科訓練。

主要關注事項

班級結構

本校中一至中六級各設四班。配合高中課程,中 四至中六級設文或理科班,學生可根據自己的能 力及興趣選修不同科目。全校中一至中六級合共 二十四班,學生人數約七百六十人。

課程

修畢高中課程的學生會參加香港中學文憑考 試,除筆試及口試外,校本評核亦成為考試 一部分, 並分階段於各科實施。學生亦須自 行完成個人的學習概覽,以記錄並反思在高 中階段各方面的學習經歷。

關愛學生成長與學習支援

本校十分重視學生的全人發展與學習支援,每循 環周設生命教育課,健康與性教育組、環保組、 德育、公民及國民教育組、輔導組、職業及生涯 規劃輔導組、訓育組、課外活動組及特殊教育需 要統籌主任,均會設計不同活動、展覽、比賽、 講座、分享等,宣揚不同的主題訊息,從而培養 同學正確及可承傳的價值觀及人生態度。為了促 進班級經營,學校亦舉辦多樣化的活動,例如 「一班一活動 | 及「 Chill Day | ,讓同學們建立 一個和諧融洽的校園氛圍。學校關愛小組亦定時 安排班主任及老師會議,商討關顧學生事宜。校 本課後功課支援計劃及學生活動支援津貼,為經 濟有困難的同學提供功課與輔導支援。 另外,本 校鼓勵資優學生參與校外比賽及活動,發揮所 長,爭取更佳成績。

為提升學生的凝聚力和推廣閱讀文化,本校開設 多元學習課,讓學生參與不同活動,如班主任課 及班級經營活動、中英文閱讀及每周好書分享, 從互動學習中鞏固師生關係及學科知識。另外,





本校以學生為本,促進全方位學習,每年舉辦戶外學習日,鼓勵學生 走出課室,拓展視野。本校日常課餘活動亦多姿多彩,讓同學以輕鬆 的心情盡情享受校園生活。除了十四個學術學會外,同學可以選擇不 同類型的活動,音樂方面有西樂團、中樂團、管樂團、合唱團; 體育 方面則有各種運動相關的校隊;服務及制服團隊包括營地管理員協 會、學校義工組、公益少年團、少年警訊、崇德社、童軍、女童軍、 紅十字會青年團等;至於其他興趣小組亦包羅萬有,如天文學會、棋 藝、橋牌與桌遊學會、園藝學會、中英文劇社、中英文辯論隊等。

本校每年均會舉辦多元化的大型活動,包括聖誕音樂會、周年舞會、 聯校口語訓練、聯校音樂會等。
